**Registration:** Please register at the GSGNY website: [girlscoutsnyc.org](http://girlscoutsnyc.org). The registration fee is \$25 per year.

**Uniform:** While not a requirement of membership, Girl Scouts at each level have one encouraged element (tunic, sash or vest) for the display of official pins and awards, which will be required when girls participate in ceremonies or officially represent the Girl Scout Movement. Each girl is responsible for purchasing their Daisy uniform, **which includes the Flag, Girl Scout Council Identification set and Troop numerals (4033), (see attached diagrams)** worn in both Kindergarten and 1st grade.

**Dues:** Girl Scout dues are \$100 for the year, due at the first meeting in September. This money stays with the troop to pay for programs, snacks, supplies, activities, and recognitions.

**Cookies:** Girl Scout Cookies are so much more than just a tasty treat. Every package you buy helps the brave and bold girls who sell them create unique adventures for themselves and their troops. Girls are encouraged to sell a

minimum of 36 boxes of cookies (any additional girl in your family adds an additional 18 boxes). The monies we raise from cookie sales offset the cost of our meetings, outings, mother daughter dinner and trips.

**Future Meeting Dates:** Meetings are alternate Thursdays from dismissal to 4:30 pm. Our first meeting will be some time in September. The schedule (once set) will be posted on the St. Mel's website and also posted on our What's App group post. There will be an Investiture/rededication ceremony in November, possibly Christmas caroling in December and a Christmas party. Additional 2023 dates and 2024 *dates TBD*.

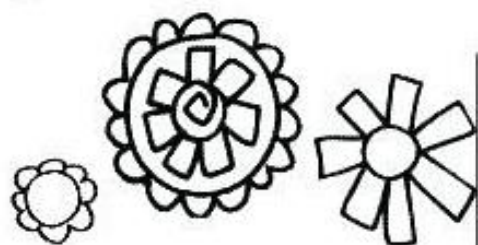

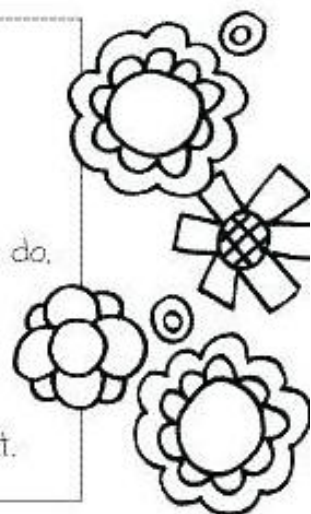
