The diocese has been using iReady as a diagnostic tool and individualized instruction plan for the past three years, but this year and going forward, iReady has replace the Terra Nova exams for diagnostic and growth assessment. iReady complements our current reading and math programs and in order to be fully effective it is recommended that students spend 20-30 minutes per week per subject working on their individualized iReady lessons with a 70% or higher passing rate. Lots of students met this target in either ELA or Math (or both!) and we are proud of their efforts!!
