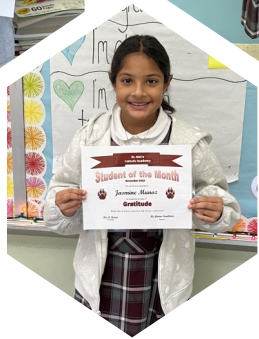
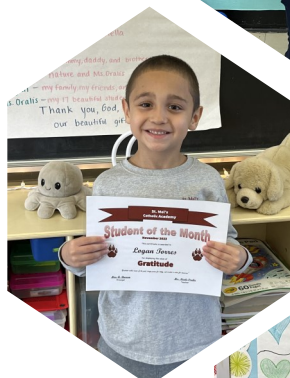
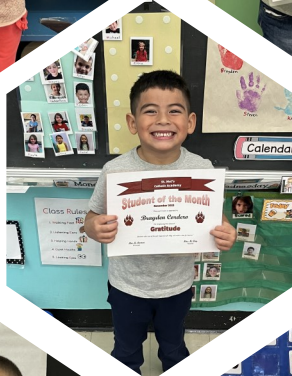
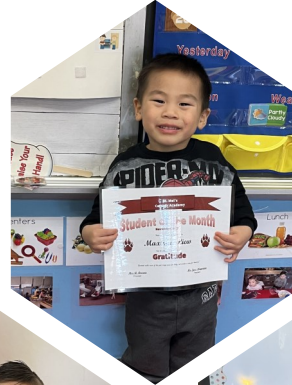
## November Student of the Month—Gratitude
