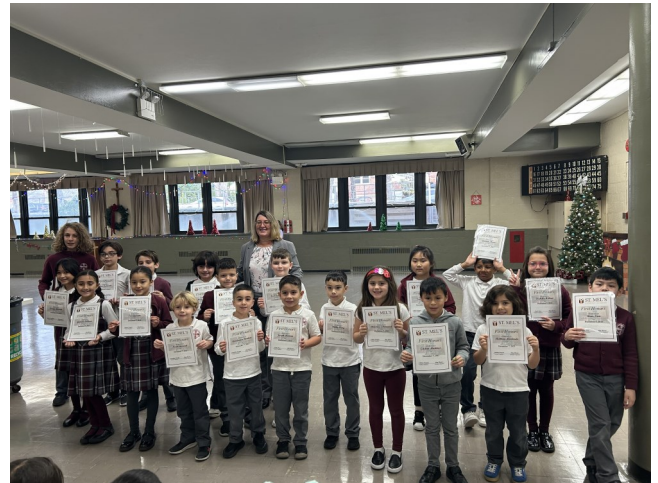


First Trimester Honor Roll Awards
