January Students of the Month

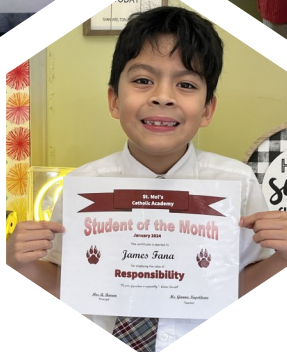
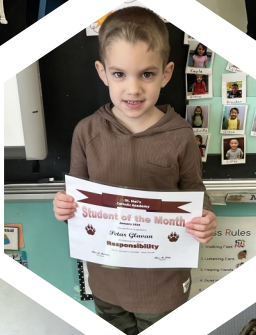
