

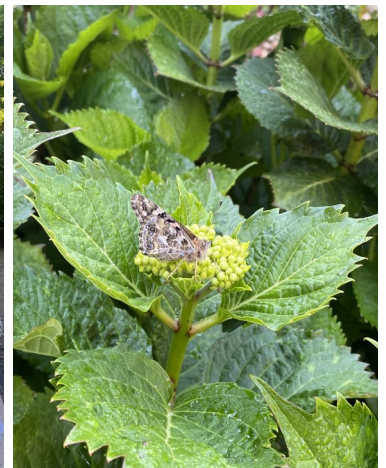

Spread Your Wings and Fly

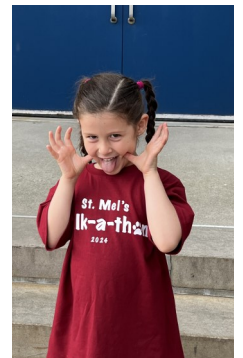
