

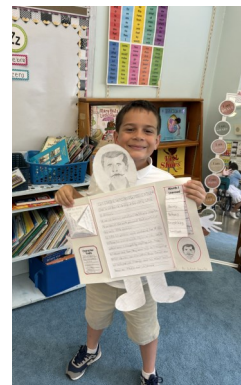
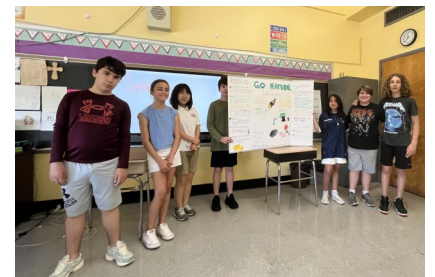
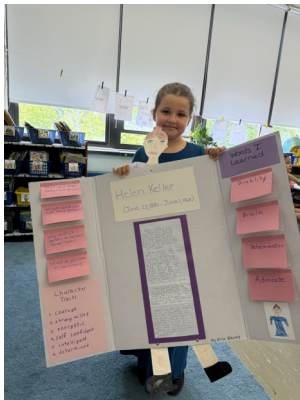

What a Week!

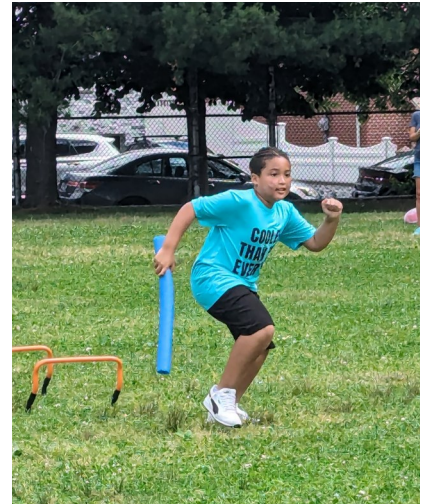
