

## Daisy Troop 4033 Newsletter

We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Girl Scouting. We hope everyone had a wonderful summer. It went by so quickly! We have many fun things planned and we cannot wait to get started. During the year we will work on our Daisy petals and activities in the Daisy handbook, do some service projects, go on trips, have parties, and hopefully have a great time together.

**All girls MUST be registered to participate in Girl Scouts. If you haven't already registered your daughter, please go to <https://mygs.girlscouts.org/> and register. The troop number is 4033.**

Our first meeting will be **Thursday, September 30, 2021**. The girls will come down directly from their classrooms ( at 3 PM) and the leaders will meet them. The other girls should arrive by 3:15. We will have a snack first, (which we will provide) and then begin our meeting. Our meetings run until 4:30 and we ask that you pick up your daughter promptly. Also, please make sure that you see one of the leaders so we know that your daughter has left with the proper adult. The girls will be dismissed thru the doors on 26<sup>th</sup> Ave. We will usually meet every other Thursday, but sometimes we will meet weekly. We would like the girls to wear their Daisy smocks to each meeting. The smocks can be purchased at the Girl scout store in Roosevelt Field or online at <https://www.girlscoutshop.com/>

Our dues for the year will be \$80 and are due now. This will cover supplies, badges, and snack throughout the year. In addition, we have a Girl Scout cookie sale each year that usually begins in January. We encourage each scout to sell a minimum of 33 boxes of cookies. If you have more than 1 daughter enrolled, each additional child must sell 18 boxes of cookies. In the past few years we have had an increasing number of people not participating in this fundraiser. The monies we raise from cookie sales offset the cost of our meetings, outings, mother daughter dinner and trips. Our program depends on these funds and in fairness to all; you are **encouraged** to participate as detailed above. Please note, that joining Girl Scouts is a commitment to the program and each other much like any other activity or team you are involved in.

**Whenever you send in money for Girl Scouts, please put in an envelope with your daughter's name on it and what it is for. Please make checks out to Girl Scout Troop 4033. This makes bookkeeping much easier.**
