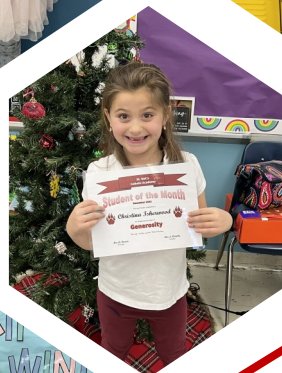
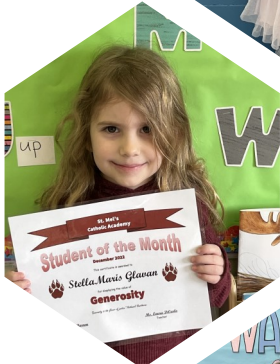
December Students of the Month

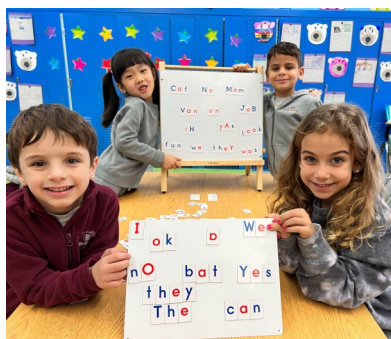
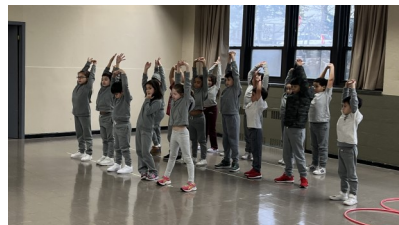
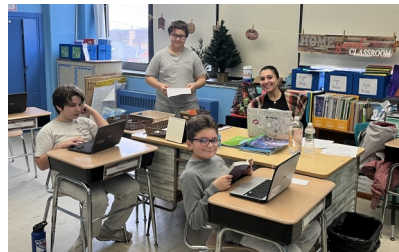


New Year...New Learning
